Delinquent Dues- There was a discussion about the Attorney's fees, the judgment awards and payment plans for people with delinquent dues.

<u>Phase 1 Bluff</u>- Mike Watson reported on area 3, from Huron Bay towards Elm. The Project has been completed. The final cost was \$151,000.00. This is a little over budget due to unexpected additional costs. The cliff is still unstable, but with time and proper maintenance, should harden and support normal everyday activity.

<u>Phase 2 Bluff</u>- The Board needs to draft a "Cover Letter" that will be mailed out to the homeowners in this Subdivision. The letter will contain information regarding Phase 2 Bluff, seeking approval of the membership to proceed with repairs and maintenance of the bluff and asking for financial support. There needs to be 51 % approval of the membership for this project to move forward. If granted, the Board will approach the Township to ask for collection help.

-Cost would be approximately 1 million to 1.3 million -Maintenance estimates could be included in the proposed cost -The DEQ has to give final approval of the project for it to go forward • TIF: Tax Increment Financing- Township retains a portion of the subdivision taxes to pay for major projects. TIF is tax deductible, in certain situations.

- Approximately \$ 143,000.00 cost
- Permits \$ 6,000.00
- It is essential to start the repairs in this area as soon as possible
