#### **Project Recap:**

**Projects 2025:** The walkway leading to Huron Bay beach was eroding so the entire area was redone. A retention wall and railing were built near the message board proving a stable walking path. Platform steps were installed on the incline path next to the railing providing a safer route down to the beach. The message board on Cedar beach bluff was also rebuilt. The Clubhouse driveway was graded with additional stone. Siding and stone were added to the base perimeter of the building closing any gaps around the building.

The hot water tank in one of the clubhouse bathrooms leaked causing some minor damage which has been repaired.

**Projects for 2026:** We will be adding a 2<sup>nd</sup> Kayak rack to the Huron Bay Beach area. Possible formation of a bluff beautification committee depending on interest. Nothing further at this time.

- **Volunteers Needed:** There are a lot of projects that could use volunteers, from Memorial Day Breakfast, Annual Picnic, cleanup days at Mill Creek, and emptying the 4 trash cans on the bluff. Please let us know if you can pitch in on projects, either by sending an email, or talking to board members at any meeting.
- **Bluff Trimming Info:** Members are reminded that no one is allowed to trim, cut, damage, or remove any vegetation, or to plant anything on the bluff, parkways, or clubhouse grounds without prior authorization. HOA will assume this responsibility.
